- Develop and teach courses in English literature, composition, and rhetoric at developmental and 2-year college level.
- Create dynamic and innovative lesson plans that cater to the diverse learning needs of our students.

- Provide constructive feedback on student assignments and facilitate meaningful discussions in the classroom.
- Maintain accurate records of student attendance, grades, and academic progress.

## Qualifications

• <u>Minimum</u> of a Master's degree in English, Composition/Rhetoric OR a graduate degree in a related field that focuses on writing or literature from an accredited institution.

- Demonstrated knowledge and expertise in the subject matter.
- Teaching experience at college or High School level preferred but not required.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
