

## Scholarship awards will be based on the following criteria:

- Financial need
- 2.0 cumulative GPA or higher
- Extracurricular engagement (e.g., church, community, school)

#### **Deadlines:**

• Fall Admissions: July 1

• Spring Admissions: December 1

#### **Submission Checklist:**

- 1. Submit a completed scholarship application.
- 2. Submit (2) personal essays:
  - a. Essay 1: Let us know why you should be considered for a scholarship. Please provide us with a brief personal background that includes extracurricular activities, community service, church involvement, and employment for the past four years.
  - b. Essay 2: Please tell us about your relationship with Jesus Christ.
- 3. Provide a letter of recommendation from a non-relative (e.g., employer, teacher, coach, or community member) who can speak to your character and preparedness for college.
- 4. Complete the FAFSA (please add Pacific Northwest Christian College for your selected school). Turn a completed FAFSA Estimated Family Contribution or forward your FAFSA Confirmation page to <a href="mailto:financialaid@pnwcc.edu">financialaid@pnwcc.edu</a>

#### Renewal:

Scholarship monies will be re-evaluated each semester. Any student receiving a partial or full scholarship must maintain a cumulative 2.0 GPA, complete the FAFSA annually, and remain in good financial standing with the college.

PNWCC Commitment Scholarship is conditional on chapel attendance, cumulative GPA, and completing your AA with PNWCC. If these conditions are not met, the scholarship will be reduced or revoked, and you will be responsible for paying back the full amount.

## Completion:

The commitment scholarship is awarded to students who are dedicated to the completion of their Associates of Arts Degree with PNWCC. As such, if a student does not complete their Associates of Arts Degree at PNWCC, they will be responsible for reimbursing PNWCC for the full awarded amount.

Should an awardee decide to transfer before the completion of their Associates of Arts or withdraw from the college in extreme extenuating circumstances, the PNWCC Administration will be responsible for determining whether reimbursement for the full awarded amount is necessary. Such decisions will be determined on a case-by-case basis by any number of the staff. A formal written request must be submitted by the student to the Academic Dean for consideration in such circumstances.
