

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Offered Collaboratively by

CENTRAL WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY

and

Pacific Northwest Christian College

for

Course Equivalencies for CWU

Central Washington University (CWU) and Pacific Northwest Christian College hereby establish an articulation agreement leading to course equivalencies toward CWU General Education. All course equivalencies will be confirmed by CWU.

This agreement will begin in the **Fall 2026** academic year. The parties commit to offering this program until dissolved by mutual agreement. An evaluation of the program will be conducted every three years.

Students from Pacific Northwest Christian College will earn course credit toward CWU General Education requirements. Transferred courses must have a minimum grade of **2.0** to be applied under this articulation agreement.

Exhibit A provides the courses students should take as part of their associate degree requirements and the corresponding CWU General Education equivalencies.

Additional Requirements

All students seeking a bachelor's degree must complete UNIV 101 and satisfy the foreign language requirement through one of the following:

1. One year of college/university study of a single foreign language; or
2. Two years of high school study of a single foreign language; or
3. Completion of an Associate in Arts – Direct Transfer Agreement (AA-DTA).

Tuition will be billed to each student at CWU's prevailing cost-per-credit rate for all courses.

CWU Admission Requirements

4. Complete the CWU Application for Admission at cwu.edu/admissions/apply-now
5. Submit a non-refundable \$50 application fee (Visa or Mastercard credit/debit card). Applications will not be processed until payment is received.
6. Students transferring to CWU with an AA-DTA must have a minimum cumulative transferable GPA of 2.0 from all previously attended colleges or universities.

All enrolled students are eligible to apply for financial aid at CWU. Each student's situation will be evaluated on an individual basis. Students must apply through CWU's Financial Aid Office.

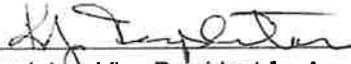
