# What is Title IX?

Federal law prohibiting sex discrimination in education.

Protects all students.

Covers classes, athletics, housing, employment, and campus activities.

# Consent

01

Consent is informed, voluntary, and can be withdrawn at any time.

02

Silence or lack of resistance is not consent.

03

Someone incapacitated by drugs or alcohol cannot give consent.

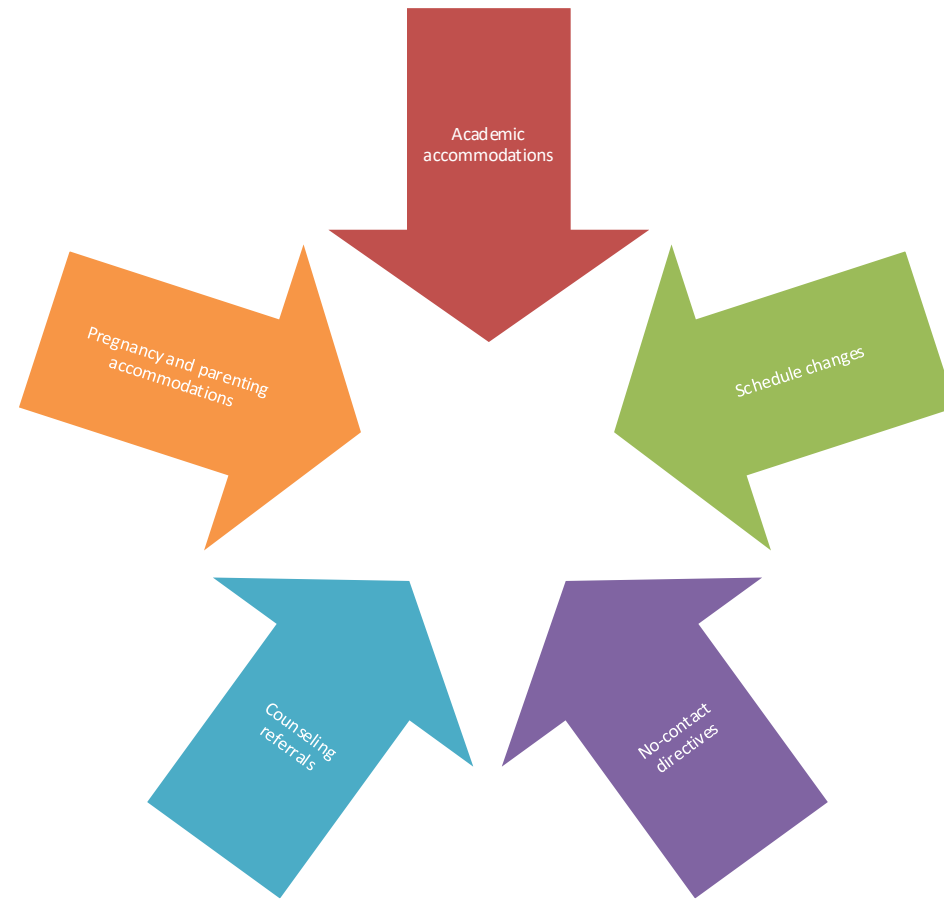
REPORT ONLINE, BY EMAIL, OR IN
